The Montana Board of Oil and Gas Conservation is sponsoring the expenses of the Workshop. All lodging, meals, and course materials will be provided for the participants at no charge. A registration deposit of \$100 will be refunded during the workshop. Attendees will earn 40 Renewal Units toward Montana Educator license requirements.

Lodging, meals, and classroom facilities for the 5-day Workshop will be on the campus of Montana State University-Billings.

Registration will be limited to 40 participants, and prompt registration is encouraged.
